Make a card for him and decorate it with markers and stickers. You'll be surprised how God can work through you to bring healing and comfort.

This week, find a Bible verse that talks about God's power working through us. Use the concordance, or ask your parents if you need help. You are not too young to be used by the living God. God needs witnesses for His name in every school, every city, and every corner of the globe. He will put you where He needs you to be—He'll even give you the words to say.

Your Challenge:

Think of three things you believe God could do through you. They could be as simple as "Give an encouraging word to someone who's down" or as grand as "Give my Christian testimony to thousands at a big event." Write down these three things and pray over them every night for a week. Ask God to prepare you for the opportunity to serve Him. It may be in ten years, or it might be tomorrow—you never know when God will use you to touch someone's life in a big way!
